
INTRODUCTION

This catalog provides a complete listing of all active SINGLE and MULTI-ENGINE PROPELLER-DRIVEN AIRCRAFT ACCESSORY and SERVICE KITS available from Cessna Parts Distribution as of the date of this publication.

Arrangement of Catalog:

The catalog is divided into four sections. Section 1 consists of Single Engine Accessory Kits and Section 2 consists of Multi-engine Accessory Kits. Section 3 consists of Single Engine Service Kits and Section 4 consists of Multi-engine Service Kits.

Accessory Kit Sections:

The Accessory Kit Sections contain an alphabetical index by Accessory Title for each accessory.

NOTE

In reviewing this index, you will note that some additions and deletions of kit offerings have been made. Deletion of kits previously offered has been made on the basis of sales inactivity.

The alphabetical index lists all accessories offered on Models and accessories for prior years which are still active. It lists the Accessory Kit Number, if applicable, the accessory status and airplane model effectivity. By reviewing the index status, you can determine how the accessory will be offered through the Cessna Service Facility organization. Listed below are the accessory status definitions:

- A - Active Accessory Kit - available on request.
- MTO - Made to Order - Accessory Kit development will start after firm order received.
- DETAILS- Accessory/Service Kit no longer available - detail parts may still be available.

When ordering an "A" Accessory Kit, refer to the index for the Accessory Kit number and applicable serial number.

Since MTO Accessory Kits are "Made to Order", no development will start until Cessna receives an order, at which time, work is started on the Accessory Kit. When ordering MTO Accessory Kits -

1. Order Accessory Kit on separate order.
2. Give complete Accessory Title.
3. Give Model and Serial Number of airplane on which Accessory Kit is to be installed.

After receipt of initial inquiry on MTO Accessory Kits, every effort will be made to provide price and delivery information as quickly as possible. On an average, this information will be provided within 3 to 5 days on previously developed Accessory Kits and within 10 to 15 days on new undeveloped kits. The average lead time on delivery of the complete MTO Accessory Kit will be 45 to 60 days after receipt of firm order.

Service Kit Section:

The Service Kits are listed alphabetically by Service Kit Title, for each Single and Multi-engine Service Kit.

IMPORTANT

Locate the kit number required and check the serial number effectivity of the kit to ascertain that it is applicable to the airplane for which the kit is being ordered.

A cross reference is made to the Service Bulletin Number in which the kit was originally announced. Information regarding the details of the kit will be found by referring to your Service Bulletin files. Make sure you reference the latest revision to the Service Bulletin.
